CAPTURE THE MOMENT.

There will be two solar eclipses (one annular and one total) taking place in October and April respectively, both bisecting our state. The total eclipse will be a <u>once-in-a-lifetime opportunity</u> for youth to experience, learn, and possibly even photograph.

DATES:

- October 14, 2023 annular eclipse (the moon is too far away from earth to completely obscure the sun)
- April 8, 2024 total eclipse (moon fully obscures the sun)
 - See NASA's eclipse map

SAFETY TIPS:


Practice proper eye safety and never look directly at the sun/eclipse without proper certified solar glasses. Certified glasses should be labeled with "ISO 12312-2:2015". Or watch the progression of the eclipse passively through a pinhole camera. Anyone using any type of camera equipment to take photos or videos of the approaching eclipse should use a certified solar lens filter on their camera. Anything with a lens (like binoculars) should also have a solar filter. A simple UV filter is not sufficient. Please consult with professional camera equipment dealers when making those purchases. Never look through the camera's viewfinder while viewing the sun/eclipse. Instead, use the live view on the camera's screen if so equipped. Taking a photo with rapidly changing light conditions requires a great deal of camera knowledge and skill, so rather than struggling with the equipment and missing the whole thing, consider just enjoying the moment. Be present as they say.

COUNTY QUALIFYING CONTEST

To compete in the Texas 4-H State Photography Contest, senior 4-H members (9th - 12th grade) MUST first qualify on the county level.

Each county may have only one entry per category for a total of 15 entries in the State Photography Contest. Not all entries on the county level will qualify for state. Once receiving notice of qualification, 4-H members will need to register for the State Photography contest on 4HOnline and upload their photos to Submittable.
